

## **Main requirements for ensuring the security of the International Youth Forum Eurasia Global 2021**

In order to ensure the sanitary and epidemiological well-being of participants and volunteers of the International Youth Forum "Eurasia Global" (hereinafter the Forum), on the basis of the resolution of the Chief State Sanitary Doctor of the Russian Federation No. 21 dated 29.07.2021 "On Amendments to the Resolutions of the Chief State Sanitary Doctor of the Russian Federation No. 7 dated 18.03.2020 and of 30.03.2020 No. 9", Decree of the Governor of the Orenburg Region dated 30.06.2021 No. 323-UK "On amendments to the Decree of the Governor of the Orenburg region dated 17.03.2020 №112-UK "On measures to counter the spread of the new coronavirus infection (2019-nCoV)", on the basis of methodical recommendations on the organizing and holding of youth forums in the all-Russian youth forum campaign of the Federal Agency for youth Affairs dated 07.04.2021 the requirements for the participants of the Forum are defined, namely:

1. A mandatory condition is the availability of a medical document (in Russian or English) confirming the negative result of a laboratory study of the material on COVID-19 by polymerase chain reaction (PCR), collected no earlier than 3 calendar days before arrival at the Forum (hereinafter – the Medical Document).

Upon arrival at the Forum in Orenburg, the Forum participant provides the organizers and/or medical workers the Medical document.

2. No later than 24 hours before arriving in Orenburg, the Forum participant sends a Medical document in electronic form (photo/scan) for review by the Forum Working Group at the following email address: [eurasiaglobal@fadm.gov.ru](mailto:eurasiaglobal@fadm.gov.ru)

3. In the absence of a Medical document upon arrival in Orenburg, the participant is isolated until the result of a laboratory test for COVID-19 is received (waiting for the result of the study is up to 3 calendar days).

4. For participants from the region of the Russian Federation, it is mandatory to have certificates of health status (a certificate on form 086-y or a certificate for obtaining a driver's license or a valid medical history card) and a certificate of absence of contact with patients with infectious diseases, issued not earlier than 3 calendar days before arrival at the Forum.

5. In case of symptoms of COVID-19, the participant is isolated and sent for laboratory testing for COVID-19. In case of detection of COVID-19, he/she is placed for treatment in a hospital of an infectious profile of the Orenburg region, and all costs associated with returning to the place of residence are paid by him/her.

6. If you have a certificate of vaccination against the new coronavirus infection (COVID-19), you must notify the Working Group of the Forum, as well as send the document in electronic form (photo / scan) to the email address: [eurasiaglobal@fadm.gov.ru](mailto:eurasiaglobal@fadm.gov.ru) before arriving at the Forum venue.
